

- 6.2 miles
- Race starts at Lower Lyndon Street Boat Launch in Caribou
- Race ends at Forbes Pit at 1100 Ft Fairfield Road, Caribou
- 2 boats will be released at 2-minute intervals beginning at 10am
- Shuttle service back to race start at completion of race
- All boats must be off the river by 12:30 pm, otherwise boaters will be responsible for their own safety.
- Race Director has ultimate decision making on classification of vessel.
- All Maine Boating Laws are applicable
- Coast Guard approved life jackets must be worn
- Under 18 must have signed permission of parent or guardian
- Under 14 must be accompanied by someone over the age of 21
